By car

The Assessment Centre is located on Oxford Road (A418) in the town centre.

There are no visitor parking spaces apart from a small number of bays for Blue Badge holders. The nearest car parks are the Whitehall Street Car Park on the opposite side of Oxford Road and the Cooper's Yard Car Park off Buckingham Street.

The below provides information on bus and train routes. We recommend checking before travelling.

By bus

Aylesbury bus station on Great Western Street is located approximately 0.5 miles from the Assessment Centre.

The nearest bus stop is at White Hill, opposite the Assessment Centre. Routes include 2, 4, 16, 17 and 60.

By train

Aylesbury railway station is around 0.6 miles from the Assessment Centre.

Services at the station are operated by Chiltern Railways, with trains running from London Marylebone via Amersham and High Wycombe, Aylesbury Vale Parkway and Princes Risborough.
